# MATERIALS



## Isacord Thread Colors

- 0010 Silky White
- 0020 Black
- 1362 Shrimp
- 1521 Flamingo
- 1725 Terra Cotta
- 2363 Carnation
- 2550 Soft Pink
- 2702 Grape Jelly
- 2830 Wild Iris
- 2910 Grape
- 4740 Aquamarine
- 5005 Rain Forest
- 5010 Scotty Green
- 5115 Baccarat Green
- 5220 Silver Sage

**Note: One spool of 1000 meter thread is adequate for the project unless otherwise noted.**



# MATERIALS



## Stabilizers

- OESD PolyMesh CutAway
- OESD Fusible Woven Black

## Fabrics/Textiles

- Quilter's Cotton: assorted colors 6" x 6" (2)
- Small amount of Poly-fil stuffing
- Small button for center (optional)

## Notion & Tools

- OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway
- OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth
- OESD Grippy GRID
- OESD Alligator Clamps (used for stuffing)
- OESD Expert Point and Press Tool
- OESD Button Clips
- Hand Sewing Needle for tufting
- Embroidery Needle Ballpoint 75/11

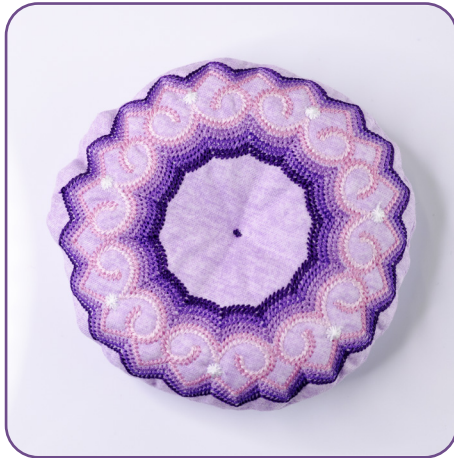

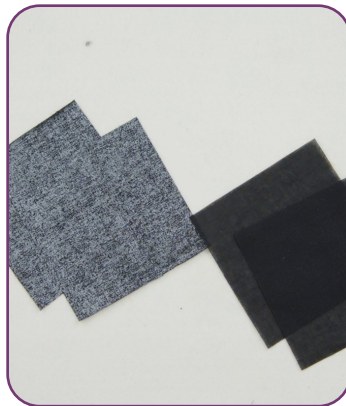
## General Instructions

The embroidery instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.

Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

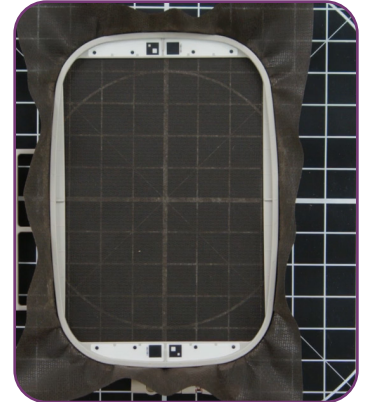
### Step 1

- Cut two pieces of Fusible Woven 6" x 6".
- Apply one layer of Fusible Woven to the wrong side of each piece of fabric.



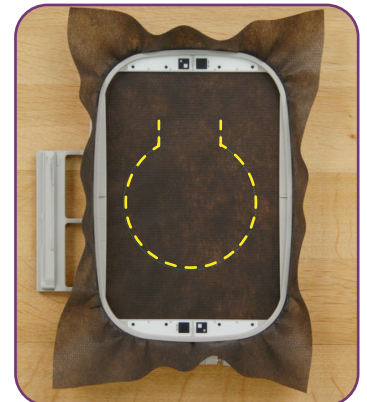
## Step 2

- Hoop one layer of PolyMesh.



## Step 3

- Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10042-03.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Black Fabric Placement Stitch.



## Step 4

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place one piece of prepared fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Carefully tape to secure.



# EMBROIDERY

## □ Step 5

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Tackdown.
- Stitch Machine Steps 3-8 Details, changing threads per thread chart.
- STOP before the last machine step.



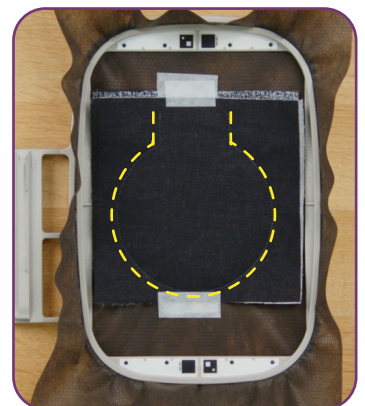
## □ Step 6

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place one piece of prepared fabric, right side down, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Carefully tape to secure.



## □ Step 7

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 9, Seam Stitch/Match Fabric.





# EMBROIDERY

## □ Step 8

- When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim 1/4" outside the design.



## □ Step 9

- Turn right side out.
- Use the Point and Press Tool to smooth out the edges.
- Press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.





## Step 10

- Use the Alligator Clamps to add stuffing to the inside.
- Fill as desired.



## Step 11

- Trim "neck" to approximately 1/2".
- Turn fabric into the opening.
- Hold in place with Button Clips.
- Machine or hand stitch to close the opening.



# EMBROIDERY

## □ Step 12

- Thread a hand sewing needle with doubled thread.
- Sew through the center marking several times, pulling tightly to secure the center.
- Add a button if desired.



## □ Step 13

- The project is complete. Enjoy!
